

## **SEPTEMBER – Week #1**

### **Tuesday, September 4**

#### **1:00 p.m. “Road Runners Workshop” @ Holiday Inn, Fairmont**

From I-79: Take exit number 137/Downtown exit. If you are coming from Clarksburg, you will take right off the exit and make an immediate left. If you are coming from Morgantown, you will make a left off the exit. Be careful, as you will cross one lane of traffic! Go under the underpass, and make an immediate left turn. Holiday Inn will be at the top of the hill.

### **Wednesday, September 5**

#### **9:00 a.m. Grafton High School**

**(304) 265-3047**

Take Route 250 South to the intersection of Route 50. Take Route 50 East. Just before the city of Grafton, you will come to a bridge over Tygart River (do not cross the bridge). Turn right here onto Riverside Drive. School is approximately 1.6 miles on the right.

#### **1:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. Marion County Schools @ Middletown Mall (304) 657-7250**

I-79 North: Take South Fairmont exit # 132. Bear right off the exit (Route 250 South). At first stoplight, turn left. The mall will be in front of you.

I-79 South: Take South Fairmont exit #132. At stoplight, turn left (Route 250 South). At the third stoplight, take a left. The mall will be in front of you.

Travel through Kingwood on Route 7 East. As you leave Kingwood, go approximately 2 miles, then turn right onto Route 72 South. Do NOT cross the bridge over Cheat River. Travel approximately 2 miles, the Armed Forces Reserve Center is on the right.

### **Monday, September 10**

**9:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. James Monroe High School (304) 753-5182**

From Lewisburg: Follow Route 219 South 21 miles to Union. Continue on Route 219 13.5 miles further to Lindsides. Upon entering Lindsides, an unincorporated community, watch for the high school on the right. There's a sign on Route 219 marking the entrance to the school.

From Princeton/Bluefield: Take Route 460 East toward Pearisburg, VA. Travel 11 miles to VA border. Go 4 miles further to junction with Route 219 North. Continue on Route 219 N 12 miles to high school, on left.

**1:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. Greenbrier East High School (304) 647-4404**

Take 219 N, past the fairgrounds. Turn left at Greenbrier Motors and left again at the intersection of 219 South, one way. Pass the state fairgrounds again and the school will be just ahead, on the right. Check with the school security guard before parking.

### **Tuesday, September 11**

**9:00 a.m. – 10:30 a.m. Greenbrier West High School (304) 438-6191**

From Beckley, take I-64 East toward Lewisburg. Continue on I-64 East 32 miles to Exit 156 Rupert/Sam Black Church. After exiting, turn left onto Route 60 West and travel 10 miles to the high school, in Charmco. School entrance is on the right, just past the Dairy Bar. If you get to the junction with Route 20, you just passed the school.

**1:00 p.m. – 2:30 p.m. Summers County High School (304) 466-6040**

Take a right and get back on Route 60 East. Merge onto I-64 West toward Beckley. Take Exit 139 toward Sandstone/Hinton; turn left off the exit onto Route 20. Drive approximately 7 miles. The school will be on your right across the railroad tracks.

### **Wednesday, September 12**

**8:30 a.m. Mercer County Schools @ Princeton Senior High School (304) 487-1096**

From Exit 9 in Princeton: take US 460 West to the third stoplight and take a right onto Ingleside Road. Go to the first stoplight and turn left on Stafford Drive. The high school is just ahead on the left.

**1:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. McDowell County Schools at Welch Armory (304) 938-3538**

From Athens: follow Route 20 South for approximately 20 miles until you reach US-52. Turn right on US-52. Follow US 52 North for approximately 24 miles. Turn right onto US-52 Alt./Virginia Street. Turn right on Howard Street/WV 16 ALT. Turn right on Wyoming Street, Route 16. Armory will be on your right.

**Thursday, September 13**

**12:30 p.m. – 2:30 p.m. Oak Hill & Mount Hope High Schools @ Oak Hill High School  
(304) 469-3551**

From Beckley, take I-77 to Exit 148 (US-19), then US 19 North to Olyer Avenue Exit at Oak Hill. Turn left off the exit and continue on Olyer Avenue past the Holiday Inn. (Don't turn left onto Virginia Ave!) Olyer Ave. will take you past the vocational school and directly to the high school.

**7:00 p.m. Nicholas County High School (304) 872-2141**

Backtrack to US 19. Merge back on US 19 North/Mountaineer EXPY via the ramp on the left toward Summersville. Turn right onto CR-19 / 50 / School Road. Turn left onto Grizzly Lane. The school will be about a tenth of a mile ahead.

**Friday, September 14**

**8:30 a.m. – 10:00 a.m. Meadow Bridge & Midland Trail H.S. @ Midland Trail H.S.  
(304) 658-5184**

From Beckley (exit 44 Harper Road) take I-77 North two miles to Exit # 48 / Route 19 (toward Summersville). Travel 28 miles on Route 19 North to Route 60/Midland Trail. (This will take you by Oak Hill and Fayetteville.) Turn left onto Route 60 East toward Rupert/Rainelle. School entrance is on the left about .5 miles from Route 19.

**1:00 p.m. – 2:30 p.m. Fayetteville High School (304) 574-0560**

Get back on Route 19 South. Continue to exit for Laurel Creek Road. Turn left onto Laurel Creek Rd. and follow it approximately 1/2 mile to junction with Maple Ave. Proceed directly across Maple Ave. to the high school.

## **SEPTEMBER – Week #3**

### **Monday, September 17**

**9:00 a.m. – 10:30 a.m. Pocahontas County High School (304) 799-6565**

From Snowshoe: Backtrack on Route 66 to Route 28 South. Turn right onto Rt. 28/Rt. 92 South. Go about 4 miles and turn right onto Route 28. There is a little Exxon Station/Country Store on the corner. From this point, travel about five miles. High school entrance is on the left, just beyond Seneca State forest.

From Elkins: Take route 250 South out of Elkins all the way to junction of Route 28 in Frank. Turn right onto Route 28 South. Follow 28 South about 16 miles and turn right onto Route 18 South at the Exxon Station above. School is about five miles down on the right.

**1:00 p.m. Richwood High School (304) 846-2591**

Start out on WV-28. Turn right to stay on WV-28, then turn right on WV-39. Turn left onto US 219/WV-39/WV-55. Turn right onto WV-39/WV-55. Travel approximately 28 miles and turn right to stay on WV-39/WV-55. Turn left onto Oakford Avenue and you will see the school.

### **Tuesday, September 18**

**9:00 a.m. Webster County High School (304) 846-2591**

From Summersville, take Route 19 North a short distance to Route 41 North toward Craigs ville/Webster Springs. Follow Route 41 North 7 miles to junction with Route 55. Turn right onto Route 55 East and continue about 7 miles to Craigs ville. At Craigs ville, continue straight on Route 20 North and continue 10 miles to Cowen. At Cowen, turn right to stay on Route 20 North and continue 3.3 miles to high school entrance, on the right. Turn at State Police headquarters sign. School is at the top of the hill. Allow 1 hour driving time.

**6:00 p.m. Wyoming County Schools @ SWVCTC in Pineville (304) 294-8346**

Back-track to US-19 South. Follow US-19 South to I-77 South. Take I-77 South to Exit #42 (Robert C. Byrd Drive/Mabscott), and follow the signs for Mullens/Sophia. Follow Route 54 South towards Mullens. Follow 54 South (approx. 13 miles) to Maben. Turn right onto Route 97 West. Follow Route 97 until the road “Ts”. Go left, and SWVCTC will be on your left (turn at sign on follow road up the hill to campus).

**9:00 a.m. – 12:00 noon Raleigh Co. Schools @ Raleigh Co. Armory (304) 256-4646  
Ext. 103**

From Beckley, Take I-77 South to I-64 East toward Lewisburg. Go 4 miles on I-64 to Exit #124/Eisenhower Drive. Follow Eisenhower Dr./Route 19 North 1.7 miles to the armory, on the right. Go left to park behind the armory. Allow 15 minutes travel time.

**Thursday, September 20**

**9:00 a.m. Braxton County High School**

**(304) 765-7331**

**Ext. 1017**

From Summersville, follow Route 19 North to I-79 North. Take the Flatwoods exit #67. Turn left off the exit then right at traffic signal onto Route 4 South. Go .7 miles and turn left at traffic light onto Jerry Burton Drive. Follow Jerry Burton Drive past state police barracks to school at top of the hill. Allow 1 hour driving time from Summersville.

**1:00 p.m. – 2:30 p.m. Lewis County High School**

**(304) 269-8348**

Take I-79 North toward Clarksburg. Take Exit 96 toward South Weston. Bear right off of the exit toward Route 19/South Weston and continue a short distance to a stop sign. This is the junction with Route 19. Proceed straight across Route 19 onto LCHS campus. School is at the top of the hill.

**6:30 p.m. – 8:30 p.m. Harrison County Schools @ Meadowbrook Mall (304) 326-7338**

Back-track to I-79. Take I-79 North to Exit #121 (Meadowbrook Road). Turn left off the exit, and get into the right lane. Follow the road through two lights, then bear right up the hill to the mall. Drive around to the back of the mall. The main entrance is near the center at the Food Court. Check-in will be in the center of the mall.

**9:00 a.m. Buckhannon-Upshur High School**

From Morgantown/Fairmont, take I-79 South to Exit #99. Take Route 33 East about 15 miles, to Route 20 exit (marked Philippi/Buckhannon). Turn right onto Route 20 South and continue ½ mile into downtown Buckhannon. At Main Street, proceed straight through signal to stay on Route 20 South. Go 1.7 miles to Tennerton (Armory on the left). Continue about 2 ½ miles further on Route 20 to high school, on the left, near the State Police Headquarters.

**1:00 p.m. Phillip Barbour High School**

From Buckhannon-Upshur High, turn right and proceed North on Route 20. You will stay on Route 20 North for about 10 miles. Just past Hodgesville, turn right onto Route 119 North. You will stay on Route 119 all the way to Philippi. In Philippi, turn right onto Truck Route 250. At stop sign, turn right to continue on Route 250 South. Continue 3.7 miles further on Route 250 to high school, on the left. It's just beyond the State Police barracks. Allow 45 mins. driving time.

## **SEPTEMBER – Week #4**

### **Monday, September 24**

#### **9:00 a.m. Randolph County Schools @ Elkins High School (304) 636-9150**

From I-79, take exit 99/Weston Exit and take Rt. 33 East towards Buckhannon. Continue on Rt. 33 until you reach Elkins. Take the Crystal Springs Exit and continue straight through town. At 4-way stop (Kroger on Right) continue straight onto the 4-lane. Just beyond K-Mart and Wal-Mart, there will be a traffic signal. Turn right at the light onto Kennedy Drive and follow to the high school.

### **Tuesday, September 25**

#### **9:00 a.m. Gilmer County High School (304) 462-7960**

Take I-79 South (towards Charleston) to Exit 79. Take Route 5 West and follow to Glenville. At the junction of Route 5/Route 33 (at stop sign just past McDonalds), turn left toward downtown Glenville. At traffic light, turn right on Route 5. (Pizza Hut here) Then almost immediately turn right again onto Walnut Street. (There's a sign for Public Library here). High school is at the top of the hill on the left just beyond the Library.

*Allow 1.5 hours if you stay in Elkins.*

#### **1:00 p.m. Calhoun Country High School (304) 354-6148**

From Gilmer County High School: Take a right out of the parking lot onto Pine Street. At stop sign, turn right onto Rt. 5 West towards Grantsville. Travel approx. 21 miles to four-way flashing caution light. At light, turn left onto Rt. 16 South. Continue approx. 5 miles to Mt. Zion. High School is on the right.

### **Wednesday, September 26**

#### **9:00 a.m. Wirt County High School (304) 275-4241**

From I-77, take the Mineral Wells Exit (#170) and turn onto Route 14 South. Follow Rt.14 South (you will make a SHARP left up the hill as you are going out of town in order to stay on Rt. 14 South!!). Follow this road appx. 12 miles into Elizabeth. At first stop sign in Elizabeth, turn left onto Court Street then take an immediate right onto Mulberry. High school is on the left beside the public library. Parking is on the street.

#### **4:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. Wood County Schools @ WVU-P (304) 420-9595**

Backtrack to I-77. Go North to the Staunton Ave. exit (#174). Turn on to Rt. 47 West. WVU-P is on the right. The Multi-purpose room is located in the campus activities center off the main campus entrance.

### **Thursday, September 27**

#### **9:00 a.m. Ravenswood High School (304) 273-2652**

Travel I-77 North to Exit #146. Turn left onto Route 2. Continue on Route 2 South 1.5 miles to traffic signal. Turn right at signal toward Ravenswood. Follow this road, Walnut Street, one mile to Henry Street. (There's a Lutheran Church on the corner of Walnut and Henry). Turn onto Henry Street and follow it through the 4 way stop to the high school on the left. Allow 1 hour from Mineral Wells.

**1:00 p.m. Ripley High School**

Backtrack to I-77 South and take Exit 138/Ripley. Follow Route 33 East into Ripley. At junction with Route 21 turn right onto Route 21 South. Go .9 miles to traffic signal and turn left to enter school campus. Drive around back of the school to the annex building where the program will be held.

**9:00 a.m. – 10:30 a.m. Ritchie County High School**

From I-77/ Parkersburg take Route 50 West. Travel about 15 miles on Route 50 to Ritchie County High School on the right. School is located just past the Ellenboro/Route 16 junction. Allow 30 minutes driving time.

**1:00 p.m. – 2:30 p.m. Doddridge County High School**

Take a left out of the parking lot of Ritchie County High School..Turn left onto U.S. Route 50 East toward Clarksburg. On U.S. Route 50 East you will come to WV Route 18 West Union. There's a flashing caution light with WV Route 18. Turn left onto WV Route 18 North. At the first stop sign, turn left onto Main Street, which doesn't look like a main street, then take the first left onto Church Street. Church Street is just before McCormick Hardware and takes you to a steep hill. At the top of the hill, you don't have to stop at the first intersection. Proceed to the next street, where there is a stop sign. Turn left at stop and you'll see the school straight ahead.

## **OCTOBER – Week #6**

**Monday, October 8**

**9:00 a.m. Morgantown and Clay Battelle High Schools @ Morgantown High School  
(304) 291-9264**

Take I-79 North to Exit #148 (I-68 East and University Ave. exit). At stoplight, turn left onto Rt. 119 North. Stay on Rt. 119 N coming into downtown Morgantown (will go through about 6 stoplights; will pass Waterfront Jeep, Waterfront Place Hotel, and WVU building on the left). At the 7<sup>th</sup> stoplight, turn right onto Pleasants St. (this is a one-way street) and get into right-hand lane. Will go through 2 stoplights, crossing Deckers Creek. At 2<sup>nd</sup> stoplight (Domino's Pizza on your right), turn right onto Coburn Ave. Follow Coburn around a bend to the left and high school will be on your right. Parking is very limited here—carpooling is suggested.

**1:00 p.m. University High School (304) 291-9276**

From MHS, go back towards Domino's Pizza (Coburn St. is one-way, so you'll need to go one street past Coburn then turn left toward Domino's). Cross the bridge over Deckers Creek. At the stoplight, turn right onto Spruce St. (one-way street). Follow to next stoplight and get into the right-hand lane. Go through another stoplight and then turn right onto Willey St./Rt. 119 North. Follow Willey St. about  $\frac{3}{4}$  of a mile up the hill, will make a sharp right turn (will see Willey St. Laundromat and Town Hill Bar on your right), make the first left onto Price St. (will see a sign for the high school, will pass a small apartment complex—keep going until you see the high school on your right). Parking is also tight here, but U. High is good about having students to help direct you and help with your materials.

**Tuesday, October 9**

**9:00 a.m. Oak Glen High School (304) 564-3500**

Leaving UHS, you'll eventually get back to Willey St./119 N. Take a left onto Willey St. and follow back up hill, past UHS entrance (should pass Laundromat and Town Hill again). Follow Willey St. until you come to a stoplight and stay in through-lane. Go through the stoplight and stay straight, passing Enterprise Rental on your left, BP Gas station on your right (this is the Mileground Rd.). Go straight through next stop light and wind down the hill and get into right-hand lane at next stoplight. At this light, take a right and stay in right lane going through one more stoplight (pass Glenmark Center on left and Exxon Gas/Taco Bell/Ashebrooke Station on your right). Turn right onto I-68 West and follow to where I-68 ends and I-79 begins. Stay to the right and merge onto I-79 North toward Washington, Pa. Follow I-79 for about 40 miles. Merge onto I-70 West toward Wheeling, via the exit on the left. Take exit 17, Jefferson Ave./ Pa Rt. 18. Turn right, follow signs for Rt. 18 and continue to follow Rt. 18 for about 20 miles. Merge onto US-22 W via the ramp on the LEFT toward WEIRTON (Crossing into WEST VIRGINIA). Take the Harmon Creek Rd. exit, #3 toward WV Rt. 507/Cove Rd. Turn right onto Harman Creek Rd., Harman Creek Rd. becomes Cove Rd. Turn right onto WV Rt. 2 North/Main St. and follow Rt. 2 for about 8 miles to New Cumberland. Continue through New Cumberland for about .8 miles and veer right onto Rt. 8 North at the junction. Travel 3 miles until you'll see Tomlinson Run State Park on your left. Go about .8 miles further and turn right at the high school entrance. It will be the next right after Gas Valley Rd.

**1:00 p.m. Madonna and Weir High Schools @ Weir High School (304)748-7600**

From Oak Glen High School, take a left out of high school onto Rt. 8 South, follow back to Rt. 2 South and through New Cumberland towards Weirton. Merge onto Rt. 22 East towards Pittsburgh. Take the Weirton exit #3/Harmon Creek Rd and turn right off of the exit ramp. Travel about 1.1 miles to the stoplight and turn right onto Weir Ave. Continue up the hill a short distance to the next stoplight and turn right onto Lee Ave. (may not be a sign for Lee Ave.). Travel about half a block and turn right onto South 11<sup>th</sup> St. Travel about ½ mile up the hill and the school entrance (Red Rider Rd.) is on the right.

**6:00 p.m.—8:00 p.m. Wheeling Area College Fair @ Wheeling Jesuit University (304)233-2575**

From Weir High School, Go back on RED RIDER RD toward S 11TH ST. Turn LEFT onto S 11TH ST., then turn left onto Weir Ave. Turn RIGHT onto COVE RD. Follow and then turn SLIGHT LEFT onto WV-2 S / MAIN ST. Follow Rt. 2 for about a mile, then merge onto US-22 W toward PITTSBURGH (Crossing into OHIO). Follow Rt. 22 for about a mile and ½. Then merge onto OH-7 S toward UNIVERSITY BLVD / DOWNTOWN and follow this for about 24 miles. Take the US-250 / US-40 / I-70 ramp toward WHEELING / BRIDGEPORT. Stay STRAIGHT to go onto US-250 / LINCOLN AVE. Turn LEFT onto US-250 E / US-40 E (Crossing into WEST VIRGINIA). Merge onto I-70 E and follow for about 2 miles, then take EXIT 2B toward WASHINGTON AVE. Turn LEFT onto CR-70 / 1, then turn right onto Washington Ave. Almost immediately you will see the entrance to Wheeling Jesuit University on your left (sign is low to the ground). Follow campus signs to the college fair at the McDonough Center, WJU's athletic facility.

**Wednesday, October 10**
